Activity Description

What style of leadership will you use to develop your tribe?

Game of Kings is a unique and exciting experience that will engage every member of your team, whatever individuals' personality and communication preferences.

The game requires the group to work in smaller team Tribes, with the mission of becoming the dominant Tribe of the mythical land of Kudos. It is up to each Tribe how they go about doing this; some will choose to work in collaboration with other Tribes, whilst some will choose to go it alone.

Whilst the game play at the giant map of the land continues non-stop throughout the activity, Tribes face a range of interesting and novel themed Tribal challenges positioned around the venue. They must choose who will face the challenges and who will remain at the Map each time. Successfully completing challenges earn precious resources (wood, food, gold and stone). These resources allow the purchase of land and the ability to develop villages, barracks, armies and forts to strengthen their position on the Map. The varied Tribal challenges include creative, physical, cerebral and problem solving ensuring that a wide range of skills are required to maximise success.

A fast-moving business game, successful teams are those who assess the skill sets in their Tribe and allocate tasks appropriately. They are decisive and able to create and communicate a team strategy and be prepared to tweak the strategy based upon the actions of other teams.

An award-winning experience that can be enjoyed just for fun and motivation, or as part of a facilitated learning session. This activity is genuinely a one of a kind experience that you'll always remember.



Timeline and Logistics



Timeline based on a 2.5 hour event:

- 10 Mins** Professional presenter welcomes everyone to the world of Kudos and introduces the challenge.
- 5 Mins** Teams familiarise themselves with the rules of the game and assign roles.
- 2 Hours** During the main game play, the teams share roles between the strategists on the map, the grafters completing the many varied tasks and the Herald's who maintain team communications.
- 15 Mins** All participants gather in their teams around the map for the final moves before the scores are revealed and the winners announced.

Logistical notes

- This activity is perfect for a 2-4 hour event
- Ideal team size is 6-8 people
- We would require 1 large room capable of accommodating the number of delegates in cabaret style plus additional indoor or outdoor space if possible to place Tribal challenges (nice to have but not essential)
